1. AGM HIGHLIGHTS

4. Amendments to the Constitution

At the last AGM held on 21st April 2011, the following amendments were approved by the members

Proposed amendments:

Article 4.1

Membership of the Society is open to <u>Malaysian citizens and non-citizens over the age of 18 years.</u>

Amend as:

Membership of the Society is open to <u>all forensic practitioners and those individuals who have a bona fide interest in forensic science.</u>

Article 4.2

(i) Member

Open to Malaysian citizens who have demonstrated an active interest and have exhibited professional competence in forensic science.

Amend as:

(i) Member

This is the professional category of membership and is open to individuals who have an active interest and can exhibit professional competence in forensic science.

(ii) Fellow

Senior category of membership open to those who have demonstrated distinctive contribution to the field of forensic science over a significant period.

Amend as:

(ii) Fellow

<u>This is the</u> senior <u>professional</u> category of membership <u>and is open to individual practitioners</u> who have demonstrated distinctive contribution to the field of forensic science over a significant period.

(iii) Student member

Students in fulltime study who are interested in forensic science, may at the discretion of the Committee be admitted as student member with prior written approval <u>from</u> the Vice-Chancellor of the University concerned. Student members are not eligible to vote or hold positions in the Society.

Amend as:

<u>Open to</u> students who are in fulltime study and who are interested in forensic science, may at the discretion of the Committee, be admitted as student member. <u>The applicant for student membership must have the prior written support and approval of the Vice-Chancellor of the University concerned. Student members are not eligible to vote or hold positions in the Society.</u>

(iv) Associate

Open to non-citizens who have demonstrated an active interest and have exhibited professional competence in forensic science.

Amend as:

(iv) Associate Member

Open to individuals who have a bona fide interest and can demonstrate that interest in forensic science. Associate members are not eligible to vote or hold positions in the Society

Article 9.2

All office-bearers of the Society and every officer performing executive functions in the Society shall be Malaysian citizens.

Amend as:

All office bearers of the Society and every officer performing executive functions in the Society shall be professional members of the Society, Members and Fellows.

Article 9 and 10

"Committee" (and all subsequent articles where the name "Committee" appears)

Amend as "Council"

9. COMMITTEE COUNCIL

- 9.1 A committee consisting of the following, who shall be termed the office-bearers of the Society, shall be elected once in two (2) years at the annual general meeting:
 - a. A President
 - b. A Vice-President
 - c. A Secretary
 - d. An Assistant Secretary
 - e. A Treasurer
 - f. An Assistant Treasurer
 - g. Seven (7) Ordinary Committee Members

9.2All office-bearers of the Society and every officer performing executive functions in the Society shall be Malaysian citizens.

10. DUTIES OF OFFCE-BEARERS

- 10.1 The President shall during his term of office preside at all general meetings and all meetings of the committee and shall be responsible for the proper conduct of all such meetings. He shall have the casting vote and shall sign the minutes of each meeting at the time they are approved. He shall, in conjunction with the Secretary and Treasurer sign all cheques on behalf of the Society.
- 10.2 The Vice-president shall deputize for the President during the latter's absence.
- 10.3 The Secretary shall conduct the business of the Society in accordance with the rules, and shall carry out the instructions of the general meeting and of the Committee. He shall be responsible for conducting all correspondence and keeping all books, documents and paper except the

accounts and financial records. He shall attend all meetings, and record all proceedings. He shall keep a membership register consisting of details such as name, identity card number, date and place of birth, occupation, name and address of employer and residential address. He shall in conjunction with the President and the Treasurer, sign all cheques on behalf of Society. He shall file annual returns within 60 days from the date of the annual general meeting to the Registrar of Societies.

The above amendments were passed unanimously by all the members present

5 Extraordinary General Meeting

An Extraordinary General Meeting of the Forensic Science Society of Malaysia was held on Friday, 14th October 2011 at 3.00 pm at the Auditorium, Forensic Block, Department of Chemsitry Malaysia, Jalan Sultan, Petaling Jaya

The EGM was called:

- a) To pass the amendments to the constitution made at the 3rd AGM on 21 April 2011. For the information of all the members, the proposed amendments were submitted to the Registrar of Societies together with the minutes and financial report but unfortunately the submission was delayed (exceeded 1 month, after the AGM). Hence, we have to table the amendments at an EGM and seek approval again from members, and then re-submit to the Registrar of Societies.
- b) To change the name "Committee" of the Forensic Science Society of Malaysia to "Council". This is to prevent confusion as there are now other committees

38 members of the Society attended the EGM and the amendments were passed unanimously.

The Registrar of Societies had approved our amendments in a letter dated 16th November, 2011
